The selected students must communicate their **acceptance by email to [ricerca@unime.it](mailto:ricerca@unime.it) not later than 15 November 2009.**

Courses will commence on 2 January 2010. The following documents are required for nonEU students attending the courses:

1. **Original certificate of the University qualification obtained abroad or equivalent**, with certified translation in Italian;
2. **Dichiarazione di Valore in Loco**, an official document that provides all the details of the academic career of the candidate and relevant certificates, issued by the Italian diplomatic delegation in the country of origin, against submission by the candidate of certified copy of the qualification and its certified translation in Italian;
3. **Study Visa** (all the details and procedures can be found on the web site of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs <http://www.esteri.it/visti/>), in order to subsequently apply for **a stay permit**. The stay permit is issued by the Italian local police station (Questura - Ufficio Stranieri). Afterwards the candidate will be summoned by the local police station (Questura) by SMS and letter sent by recorded delivery, in order to deposit fingerprints and receive the electronic version of the stay permit;
4. **Copy of the passport;**
5. **Valid travel documents;**
6. **A passport photo;**
7. Proof to have **enough financial means to live in Italy** (by means of economic guarantees provided by an Italian creditworthy institutions and entities, or foreign Governments, or foreign institutions and bodies regarded as reliable by the competent Italian diplomatic authority). At present, the minimum amount of money regarded as indispensable is Euro 350.57 per month;
8. Demonstration to have a suitable **accommodation** in Italy;
9. **Health insurance** giving evidence of the right to medical care in Italy.
