Enunciation and practice of fundamental rights: emigration and freedom in relation to residence

LOCATION: *Montalbano Elicona campus, University of Messina*
July 27th (day of arrival) to August 10th 2008 (day of departure).

This is a 60-hour high-level residential course, worth 3 Credits (3 CFU), held mainly in English. Lessons will be held from Monday to Friday for a total of 60 hours classroom teaching, plus a further 20 hours of additional activities with a final assessment and certificate of attendance.

PROGRAMME

Monday, July 28th, 2008: Opening ceremony.

01. *Prolusion. Freedom of residence and movement. Movement as natural freedom and basic rights: the standpoints of major legal systems. Racism as a state of mind and as culture.*
02. *Between wars and famine: the great migrations of peoples in the Mediterranean area. Colonization and birth of new civilisations.*
03. *Climate change and peoples in movement: Barbarian invasions and the formation in Europe of Latin, Germanic and Slav nations. Nations without a homeland and Europeans.*
04. *Emigration as a feature of modern and contemporary European civilisation. Stateless and homeless people.*
05. *European emigration to the Americas: the European perspective.*
06. *European emigration to the Americas: the American perspective.*
07. *Financial considerations versus ethnic prejudices. Restrictions on freedom of movement: legal problems.*
08. *Freedom of movement and residence as natural freedoms and constitutionally guaranteed rights: The Western and European perspectives.*
09. *Freedom of movement and residence as natural freedoms and constitutionally guaranteed rights: the perspective of third parties.*
10. *Conclusion. Globalization and new migratory trends.*

Saturday, August, 9th 2008: *Closing ceremony and issue of certificates*

Every “teaching module” consists of 3 two-hour lessons usually given by teachers of different nationalities.

ACCOMMODATION AND TOURIST AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES.

Students will live in an old historical village, where the climate is mild, and will take part in programmed activities in an international context.

The campus is Palazzo Todaro, an old restored and refurbished stately mansion where students will be able to freely use an Internet connection.

Students will be housed in traditional accommodation, refurbished individual rooms with ensuite bathroom and kitchen area, located in the fascinating, recently restored medieval quarter.

Meals will be available in the self-service canteen, run directly by the Municipality, situated in Palazzo Faranda, an old restored mansion.

Participation in the course includes (with no additional costs):

- a) full board (drinks excluded), for the entire course;*
- b) transfer to/from Catania airport or to/from Messina railway station (on fixed dates);*
- c) participation in guided tours of the surrounding area, cultural visits and recreational activities organized in the local medieval castle;*
- d) use of municipal sporting facilities (gym and tennis courts);*
- e) daily shuttle (fixed timetable) with Marinello beach.*

During the courses weekly activities will be organized on Sicilian history, cultural traditions and political institutions; films will be shown. At weekends, for an extra fee, students may go on excursions to: the Aeolian islands (day and night excursions in fishing boats with meals on board); Etna and its craters; the suggestive features of the River Alcantara, Taormina and Tindari, in the natural reserve of the Malabotta woods (for an extra fee, on horseback).

Formative and cultural activities will be managed by the DiSCOGiPo -Dipartimento di Storia e comparazione delle istituzioni politiche e giuridiche (Director: Alberto Russo) and by the Faculty of Political Sciences, University of Messina (Dean: Andrea Romano).

The overall management and co-ordination of teaching will be carried out by Prof. Andrea Romano.

The course enrolment fee is € 600,00 (six hundred euros) and, in addition to lessons, includes:

Full board and accommodation, tourist and cultural activities, transfer to/from Catania airport or to/from Messina railway station on the date of arrival and departure.

A few grants are also available for the best students and students from non-European Union countries.

The last date for enrolment is Juni 07th 2008. The minimum number of enrolments required is 20 students.

Students attending the International Summer School may also attend one International Language Intensive Summer Course.
