1. Location

The admission test will take place at the Polo Universitario Papardo with access from Viale Stagno d'Alcontres – Cerisi Entrance

CERISI ENTRANCE



QR-CODE to reach the location by your own means of transport via google maps (SCAN or CLICK)

Along the Viale Stagno d'Alcontres, near the Cerisi entrance, you will find signs to facilitate reaching the test site. We recommend you to follow the route suggested by signs, preferring it to the alternative ones offered by Google Maps or satellite navigation, which could be longer. In particular, you have to go up Viale Stagno d'Alcontres to the end of the central divider and make a U-turn on the left to reach the Cerisi entrance.

5. Documents

The candidate must bring with him:

- 1. a valid identification document (preferably the same document as that declared on registration). For non-EU applicants residing abroad, the passport and the entry visa;
- 2. health card/tax code;
- 3. receipt of payment of the fee for participation;

6. WARNINGS

We strongly recommend you:

- bags, backpacks, books, pens, pencils, textbooks, reproductions, even partial ones, handwritten notes, blank sheets and teaching and/or reference material, mobile phones, smartphones, smart-watches, tablets, earphones or other similar instruments, etc cannot be introduced in the classroom (penalty of cancellation of the test)
- use the toilets before entering the classroom;
- turn off mobile phones before entering in the competition area;
- food inside the classroom is forbidden except for drinks, therefore the candidates can bring with them a bottle of water and any medicine you need;
- In order for the test to be conducted correctly, the candidate must remain in the classroom until the end of the time allowed for the test.
